### Spaces – Reception and Nursery

For the first time in decades, we have a few Reception places for September 2021. Pupil numbers across Brighton & Hove and Shoreham are lower this year - possibly because of Brexit and COVID affecting both international and local migration. We also just happen to have less sibling and numbers in our nursery have also been lower this year because of COVID. So, if you know of families moving to the area, don't assume we are full, encourage them to ring the school!

Now that your child has been offered a place at St Nicolas and St Mary CE Primary School, you may like to consider applying for a place at our nursery, Little Fishes, for any younger children that you may have. We are now accepting children from aged 2, from the term in which they turn 3 years of age. For further information please look at our website. If you would like a place for September 2021 or January 2022 you are advised to contact the school office as soon as possible as places are filling up.
