Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 5 Residential Trip to Truleigh Hill - Monday 13th to Tuesday 14th September 2021

We are delighted that our Truleigh Hill trip will be taking place shortly, following several postponements!

This letter is to confirm some important details. I appreciate that some of this information is short notice – but it was not possible to plan earlier when there was still the risk of the trip not happening. As the first letter went out to parents some time ago, I have provided some additional information at the end of this letter.

Please complete and return the attached parental agreement for school to administer medicine together with any medicine your child requires by **FRIDAY 10th SEPTEMBER.** Please also hand in any medicines that your child may need whilst at Truleigh Hill.

Thank you again for payments for the trip, **FRIDAY 10th SEPTEMBER** will be the final day for outstanding payments (unless agreed otherwise with the school).

The children will be walking from the school in small groups with staff or parent volunteers. Please return the volunteer slip ASAP so that we can confirm who will be joining us on the walk from school to Truleigh Hill.

If your child has any special dietary requirements that we are not aware of, please let us know as soon as possible. Likewise, if your child has any medical or other needs that may need our attention please let us know.

Arrival time: Children need to be at school on Monday 13th at the usual time.

Pick-up Time: 2.30pm Tuesday 14th September from Truleigh Hill Youth Hostel. The children will be taking part in the end of trip celebration before then so please do not arrive earlier than 2.30pm. Staff will be unable to bring children back to school on Tuesday afternoon as they will need to pack up and transport school equipment. Parents are encourage to contact each other to arrange shared transport.

Year 5 Residential Trip to Truleigh Hill - Monday 13th to Tuesday 14th September 2021

Additional Information

This is our second residential trip to **Truleigh Hill** Youth Hostel Association. It is a fantastic, exciting residential adventure which provided some fabulous curriculum and learning experiences for children.

This trip is subject to sufficient parental support.

The trip will take place from **Monday 13**th **to Tuesday 14**th **September.** The cost of the trip is £35.00 and includes accommodation and food (except packed lunch on first day).

Further information:

- The trip will be led and organised by Mr Etherton, Miss Kite, Mr Davies and Mr DeWaal with other staff/volunteers on the team.
- The children will be sleeping in dormitories of between 2 and 8 children. Most of the beds are bunks and we will have some additional mattresses on the floor to ensure that we can accommodate everyone. We will have exclusive use of the hostel overnight.
- Children will walk from school, leaving at 9am on Monday 13th September. It is 4 miles. Children will need comfy shoes, a small rucksack, drink, packed lunch, waterproof coat and sunscreen.
 - We will ask for volunteers to walk with us to Truleigh Hill and organise a lift back at lunchtime!
 - Well-behaved dogs on a lead are welcome for the walk but children will be able to choose a non-dog group if that is their preference.
- Overnight bags will be taken up by car (we may ask for some volunteers to assist with this)
- We will be walking through Buckingham Park, through the estate, and over the hills. There will be lots of curriculum activities to do on the way such as Mill Hill Nature Reserve, map reading, treasure hunts, guizzes and problem solving.
- At the hostel we will do a range of activities such as team building exercises, shelter building, fire lighting, rounders and so on.
- Children will need to be picked up by parents from Truleigh Hill on Tuesday afternoon at 2.30pm.

Normally trips are expensive because of coach travel. We are fortunate that the hostel is nearby and we will not need to pay for travel! There is no cost for the curriculum activities so the above cost is not voluntary. However, if you wish to speak to me in confidence about the entitlement to waive charges, please contact me to arrange an appointment. Please note that this price includes a $\pounds 10$ discount per child that we have negotiated with the YHA. If you are in receipt of one of the following benefits the charges for the trip may be waived (please speak to the school office/member of staff in confidence):

- Income Support
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support from National Asylum Support Service (NASS) under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income
 of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a
