### 3. WORSHIP & ETHOS

This is amazing news, however we are taking a sensible approach and will gradually reintroduce the children back into being together in the Main Hall, starting with upper key stage 2 and each week an additional year group.

# 4. HELPFULTIPS FOR PARENTS AND CARERS!

We realise that an awful lot goes on at school and it can be difficult to keep track of everything so here are some tips to help you:

- Check the book bag daily.
- Try to take action straightaway: sign up to sQuid to ensure you can pay quickly, slips should be completed and returned to school the next day this reduces the likelihood of losing letters or forgetting about them.

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- Keep any original letters in a safe place you could set up a file just for school letters, tickets and information in a safe but handy place so you can check things when you need to.
- Read this weekly bulletin promptly make a note of any upcoming events on your calendar.
- The date list is always available on the website and is kept up-to-date as new dates get added, or sometimes amended. Add any dates that affect you or your child to your calendar straight away or highlight them and stick them on your fridge!
- When you get a letter about a school trip, add it to your calendar including time of departure and arrival to and from school, and any special requirements e.g. wet weather clothing, sunhat etc.
- Try to buy tickets for events, parties etc promptly to avoid the disappointment of missing a deadline. We hate to see children or adults disappointed but a deadline is necessary to allow preparations to be made.

## 5. PARKING

- Parking: please can we remind all parents and carers to be considerate when dropping off/picking up their children. Do not park on the zig zags, in the school bus zone, up on kerbs or in front of residents' drives it is dangerous and puts all our children at risk, as well as causing congestion on the road. There is parking available over at Buckingham Park or on nearby roads. PLEASE park carefully and considerately. The school will not hesitate to report such incidents to the police. This includes dropping off/picking up from the Octopus and Starfish clubs and any other after school clubs.
- Reporting bad or inconsiderate parking: Anybody can report bad or inconsiderate parking by going to
   <u>www.operationcrackdown.org</u> You just need to include the registration number, make and model of car, location
   of the incident. We encourage any parent/carer who witnesses dangerous parking to report it immediately.
- Staff car park: Could we please remind you that parents/carers must not use the staff car park unless they have been given prior permission to do so. The car park is extremely busy with staff arriving/departing, visitors and deliveries. Please make sure you always use the footpath between the hedge and the fence when coming in to school. Could you also please let any other members of your family know. Thank you.
- Tesco: Please do not use the Tesco car park for dropping off/picking up.

## 6. CORONAVIRUS - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

### 7. PREMISES, HEALTH & SAFETY

- Drop off and pick-up arrangements: Thank you to our parents and carers for looking through the information sent out yesterday regarding the start and end of the day. Following the drop off this morning, please find below some additional clarification points:
  - Drop off for year 3 and 4 children: Please do encourage your child to walk, on their own, from the edge of the playground, half way along the path and then go around the adventure trail on the field side (Not across the tarmac area outside year I and 2). We will have additional staff outside and signage to show the direction for the children to walk and also a parent drop off sign for any parents that for the start of term want to walk to the edge of the adventure trail (not around) and say goodbye to their child.
  - Pick up for year 3 and 4 children: The meeting pick up points are:
    - Seal: Between plastic tube and The Castle
    - **Sea Lion**: Right hand side of the plastic tube by the edge of the cherry tree playground.
    - Sea Otter: By the back of the bike shelter
    - **Seahorse**: By the blue basketball post.
- 8. SCHOOL CENSUS, THURSDAY 7<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER: It is vital that we secure the full level of funding to which we are entitled for Free School Meals. The government provides funding for each child that has a free school meal on the two census dates in October and January. If your child is entitled to a free school meal (including all children in YR, I and 2) they will be offered a hot meal on these dates, therefore they do not need to bring in a packed lunch. If your child has a dietary requirement that Chartwells are not already aware of please follow the link to read the West Sussex Special Diet Process which includes a form to return to Chartwells, otherwise you need take no further action (please see the Children's Choice Menu attached to the bulletin).
