- comb your child's hair regularly with a nit or bug-busting comb. You can buy these from your local pharmacy;
- periodically inspect the hair of all the children in the family;
- do not be embarrassed to tell the parents of any other children who may have had head-to-head contact with your child;
- thank other parents if they let you know that their child has lice.
- **5. HEXAGON ON CHERRY TREE PLAYGROUND:** For their safety, please do not let your children play on the Hexagon on the Cherry Tree Playground. The barriers will be replaced soon.
