5. GOOGLE CLASSROOM and Remote Learning:

- We wanted to say a huge thank you for all the positive comments that have come in from parents
 regarding the childrens, and for many teachers, introduction to google classroom this week. We have really
 appreciated the support of parents, and teachers have loved being able to see the children on screen. We
 do acknowledge that with anything new there will be areas to improve, which is why we are collating
 together ideas and we over the coming days will be sharing these with parents either via your child's
 teacher or to the whole school community.
- We are aware that some of our families may have a PS4 or an XBOX in the house. We have found a really useful set of instructions (see below) to show how either of these devices can be used to access Google Classrooms (particularly useful if you have more than one child at home/both yourselves and your child are trying to work at the same time!) You may find that you need a separate USB keyboard and if you do need one, school has a very small supply that we would be able to loan out to families (please only request one if the use of either games device is the only option for google classroom rather than an added extra.).
- Could we please ask you to ensure that any posts are only made during the school day (8.45am 5.15pm). Teachers have been receiving notifications at all hours of the day and night and it is vital for the well being of both staff and pupils that they work according to 'normal' school hours.

COOL MILK and FRUIT & VEGETABLE SCHEME: In light of the recent government announcement, the Cool Milk and school's fruit and vegetable scheme delivery has been cancelled with immediate effect and no future orders will be generated until further notice. - 7. HOT SCHOOL MEALS: All children who attend school during the lockdown period will be able to have a hot school meal for lunch. - 8. FREE SCHOOL MEALS: Children in all years who are entitled to Free School Meals, who are not attending school, will be able to collect a weekly food parcel from next week*. Further details of collection days/times will be sent out as soon as possible next week to parents/carers of eligible children. Parents/carers will need to adhere to all current social distancing measures. Please bring a reusable shopping bag to transport the goods back home. The Chartwells food parcel items will all be ambient apart from cheese which will need to be stored in your fridge. There are currently no plans for a term time Government FSM voucher scheme although vouchers are likely to be provided during the February Half term holiday. *Please note that this doesn't apply to children in YR, YI and Y2 who receive 'Universal Infant Free School Meals'.

9. OCTOPUS BREAKFAST & STARFISH AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

• Bookings for the first half of the spring term: Sessions for the first half of the spring term can be booked for those children attending school during the current lockdown. You can do ad-hoc bookings and do not need to book the whole term in advance; however bookings are subject to availability on a first come first served basis. We will still require 4 weeks notice of any cancellations.

• Little Octopus and Little Starfish Clubs: we currently do not run Little Octopus and Little Starfish Clubs for children in Little Fishes Nursery but, due to the current situation, this is under review.

10. VIRTUAL SPORT CHALLENGES

- Shoreham Primary Schools Sports have restarted their 'Stay at Home Virtual Games' which will involve the students using household objects or clothing to complete challenges. The first can be found on the website https://primarysport.shoreham-academy.org under the About tab and then 'Stay at Home Virtual Games'. It involves 20 challenges for catching a pair of rolled up socks which get progressively harder. A video explains and shows what to do. The challenges are suitable for all children from Reception up to Year 6 and beyond. The children have 2 weeks to achieve their highest level and then their scores should be submitted via the form on the Shoreham Schools website. This is for everyone under 18 so if you have little ones (or big ones) at home that do not go to our primary school, let them have a go and select the 'other' option on the school attended tab on the submission form. Do have a go and enter your score. The more entries: the higher our participation score.
