## 3. REMINDERS

- 4. **FIDDLE TOYS:** We have noticed a number of children bringing 'Fiddle toys' into school, which we believe is related to a craze on social media. For certain children these can be a very useful tool to allow children to focus on their learning. In such cases, conversations will have happened between teachers and parents. For children where this discussion has not taken place (e.g the toy is not required for the child) we have noted that they are proving a distraction and causing arguments between children. Therefore we would ask that these are not brought into school by the children - if they are, the teacher will look after them and return them to parents at the end of the day. Many thanks.

5. **FOREST SCHOOL:** Reception are creating an outside area for their weekly Forest Day. They are looking for small logs, rockery stones, a camping kettle, wild flower seeds/plants, a grill to go over a fire pit, metal/wooden stakes to cordon off an area and pallets to create a Bug Hotel. 6. **HEALTH & SAFETY – CORONAVIRUS – IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- **Symptoms:** if you or members of your household have symptoms of coronavirus the whole household must immediately go into self-isolation and children in the household should not attend school. Please arrange a test(s) for anyone with the symptoms urgently. This will help to ensure that in the case of a positive test result, contacts of the person can self isolate promptly to prevent further spread of infection to the wider community.

Water is available at all times.

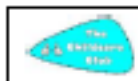
