## Spelling challenge:

Practice writing down sentences which have been dictated to you by someone else. See if you can get the spelling, grammar and punctuation all correct under pressure! Practice on a sheet of paper, then bring in the sheet to show me.

Ideas for dictated sentences:

Sentences which included homophones: <u>Where</u> will I be able to <u>wear</u> my beautiful new hat to?

Sentences with contractions: Joe <u>didn't</u> realise that you <u>shouldn't</u> sing on public buses! Sentences with speech punctuation: <u>"Watch out!"</u> yelled Maria at the jungle explorer.

Extra challenge: someone dictates 2 or 3 sentences. Can you work out where each new sentence should start?
