
#### Editing session I

- clear sentences that <u>all</u> make sense!


## Editing session 2

Now is your chance to check you have used a range of <u>conjunctions</u> in your writing. Remember to use a mixture of FANBOYS (coordinating) and ISAWAWABUB (subordinating).
