## Industrial Action - Wednesday 15th March and Thursday 16th March 2023

Dear Parents and Carers

As mentioned in our previous school communication the third and fourth days of planned strike action from the National Education Union (NEU) will take place on **Wednesday I5**<sup>th</sup> and **Thursday I6**<sup>th</sup> **March**. Our current understanding is that once again a significant number of our teaching staff will again be taking industrial action and therefore we are getting in touch to give you as much notice as possible about our arrangements for that day.

Once again, we have undertaken a robust risk assessment based upon the number of staff available and the need to ensure we continue to offer a safe and secure environment for our pupils. Based on the information we have, we have, for the third time, made the very difficult decision to **PARTIALLY OPEN** the school for a small number of children.

As per recommendations from the government and the Department for Education, the school will be open:

## On Wednesday 15th March for:

- Year 6 children.
- Children whose parents work in one of the following 'Critical Worker' professions and are unable to organise alternative childcare arrangements. Parents must confirm this through proof of identification, UNLESS YOU HAVE PREVIOUSLY SHARED THIS WITH US AT THE LAST STRIKE DAY which can be shown to a member of the school office team or a copy can be emailed to office@stnm.org.uk Please do let us know in advance so that we can organise staffing accordingly.
  - 'Blue Light' services (Fire Service, Police, Ambulance, Coast Guard-search & rescue)
  - National Health Service (NHS)
  - Education Sector (Schools that are open on the Strike day)
- A small number of additional families school will be in touch later today.
- Children of our school staff that are required to work.

## On Thursday 16th March:

- We will open for the groups of children named above plus
- **Year 4 children** to enable them, during the day, to attend their swimming lesson (following 2 missed sessions earlier in the term)

We do once again acknowledge the challenges that this creates for many of our families. We were incredibly thankful for the support and understanding shown on the previous day of industrial action and are hopeful this will continue for this and any future industrial action dates.

It is unlikely that the industrial action will be called off but, if this were to happen, we will contact parent immediately to inform you that the school will be fully open.

Currently there no further planned dates for National Education Union industrial action.

Thank you for your continued understanding and support for the school and children's education.
