 - **STEM Club:** Following a very successful introductory session earlier this week, we are very pleased that the school will be extending its enrichment opportunities through a STEM club run by STEM Innovations. More information will follow next week.

3. REQUESTS, REMINDERS AND GENERAL NOTES

- **Parent Payments:** we received notification this week that sQuid will be ceasing its payment processing services on 14 March. You should receive notification from sQuid that your account will no longer be active after 14 March. sQuid is responsible for returning any unused money in a parent's account to the parent. We as a school were planning to move our parent payments system from sQuid to Arbor in September but this news means we will be doing this in the next few weeks! We are working on this transition at the moment and will let you know as and when you need to do anything.
- b. Free School Meals (FSM) Means-tested FSMs are provided to children whose families meet specific incomerelated criteria. If you think your child may be eligible for FSMs and you are not already in receipt of them, please apply before the end of March 2025 to ensure your claim and future funding are protected. Only applications processed before 1 April 2025 will maintain transitional protection (see below).

Transitional Protection Arrangements – From 1 April 2025, the Government's transitional protection arrangements for means tested Free School Meals (FSM) will end. Any eligible claims confirmed from this date will no longer be protected. This means any child confirmed as eligible for free school meals from 1 April 2025 will be subject to ongoing checks to confirm continued eligibility. This will not impact any children who are already confirmed as eligible. Those already confirmed as eligible will maintain their eligibility until the end of their current phase of education. At that point, they will be re-assessed for their eligibility status. This will apply to all year 6 moving into year 7 in September 2025. These children will then be subject to ongoing checks to confirm continued eligibility.

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




