- Little Fishes Nursery - 30 Hour Free Childcare Code Reminder** – Just a reminder to apply now to ensure you have renewed your 30 hours free childcare code by **31 March 2025**. Log in to your childcare account to check your details are up to date and reconfirm your eligibility by **31 March 2025** to ensure you continue to be eligible for 30 hours free childcare - gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account. Contact the HMRC helpline if you are experiencing issues applying or reconfirming on 0300 1234 097.
- Free School Meals (FSM)** – Means-tested FSMs are provided to children whose families meet specific income-related criteria. If you think your child may be eligible for FSMs and you are not already in receipt of them, please apply before the end of March 2025 to ensure your claim and future funding are protected. **Only applications processed before 1 April 2025 will maintain transitional protection.**
Transitional Protection Arrangements – From 1 April 2025, the Government's transitional protection arrangements for means tested Free School Meals (FSM) will end. Any eligible claims confirmed from this date will no longer be protected. This means any child confirmed as eligible for free school meals from 1 April 2025 will be subject to ongoing checks to confirm continued eligibility. This will not impact any children who are already confirmed as eligible. Those already confirmed as eligible will maintain their eligibility until the end of

their current phase of education. At that point, they will be re-assessed for their eligibility status. This will apply to all year 6 moving into year 7 in September 2025. FSM Vouchers for Easter School Holidays 2025** - West Sussex County Council is pleased to confirm that families with Free School Meal (FSM) eligible children will, once again, be entitled to a voucher for each FSM child during the upcoming Easter school holiday 2024. FSM eligible families in West Sussex will be entitled to a £10.00 voucher per FSM child per week, which is a total of £20 per FSM child for the two-week holiday.

- 4. Christian Values Creativity Competition:** This week we have been exploring our value of creativity and thought about the many different forms our creativity can take, whether it be artwork, music, photography, writing, dance, drama or gymnastics. In the assembly on Tuesday, I launched a competition which invites the children to share examples of their own creativity linked to our school values: creativity, friendship, compassion and respect. If your child would like to enter, they can submit an entry based on any or all of our school values. They can work independently or as part of a group with their peers (demonstrating friendship). Entries can include:

- A painting, drawing or collage no bigger than A4 size.
- A sculpture or model e.g. Lego/junk modelling (or a photo of it if easier)
- A piece of creative writing such as a story, poem, prayer or poster
- A photograph they have taken to demonstrate the theme
- Performance of a song or piece of music linked to a value
- Performance of a dance or gymnastics routine linked to a value

All entries should be clearly labelled with the child or children's names and class names, and state which value/values they have chosen. If children are working on a performance piece, they must come and speak to me to let me know what they are working on so that I can arrange to see it once it is ready.

The closing date for entries is the first day back after Easter (Tues 22 April). All children who enter will receive a certificate and there will be a small prize for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. The best entries (or photos of them) will be displayed on our values celebration board and the best performances will be showcased in assembly. I look forward to seeing the children's creativity shine through and for them to be able to share this with others. Dr Bishop.




