



Your child is about to embark on a thrilling new adventure - secondary school! Now is the perfect time to do a practice journey to show off your safer crossing moves and master some of our legendary road safety rules together.

Let's all stay alert, stay safe and conquer the streets.



Look out and keep your eves on the road! Make sure you look all around and listen for traffic. Hey! Don't get distracted by your phone, friends, music, or other people!

Even if you're super-fast, being in a rush can be dangerous! STOP before you get to the kerb, so you've got time to make the right call. It's not easy to judge how fast traffic is going, so never run across the road.

Practice following these top tips with your child to help them on their future Safe Adventures!

There's a world of opportunity when you know the rules of the road.



Cross at designated crossings or choose a spot where you can see clearly in all directions. Don't be a daredevil - avoid crossing between stationary vehicles, on a bend, close to the brow of a hill. When crossing between parked cars, treat the outer edge of the cars as the kerb and make sure there is a gap on the other side, so you can reach the pavement. Look right, left, and right again before crossing.
