1. Chair's welcome

- SL welcomed everyone to the meeting,
- She explained that the main purpose of the meeting was to discuss future fundraising events.

2. Financial report

JP explained we currently have about £20,000 in the bank after a good fundraising year. We have money set aside for Computers - £1500, (Lions are paying for 2 and SB has provided 31), Lego Wall – £150, Kiln room shelving £800. We have paid for the kiln and £102 for clay, and £1800 for rubber matting for outside. Leaving approximately £18000 towards the Daily Mile track.

3. Plans for future events/fundraising, including new ideas for Summer

- 5p Bottle Challenge SL explained the challenge, each class to receive a labelled soda bottle, to collect 5p in. Each bottle contains well over £100. The class that earns the most money will receive £75, 2nd £50 and 3rd class £25 to spend on their own class. Each class can create a wish list of what they'd like to spend their money on. The challenge will run from 3/2/2020 3/4/2020.
- Glo -Disco Ticket sales for the adult disco is slow but hopefully a rush in last week, will decided next week if need to cancel. Children's disco has sold enough tickets to go ahead.
