11. HEALTH & SAFETY - CORONAVIRUS - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Symptoms:** if you or members of your household have symptoms of coronavirus the whole household <u>must</u> <u>immediately</u> go into self-isolation and children in the household should not attend school. Requirements
