3. **REMINDERS**

For children where this discussion has not taken place (e.g the toy is not required for the child) we have noted that they are proving a distraction and causing arguments between children. 6. HEALTH & SAFETY - CORONAVIRUS - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Symptoms:** if you or members of your household have symptoms of coronavirus the whole household <u>must</u> <u>immediately</u> go into self-isolation and children in the household should not attend school. Please arrange a test(s) for anyone with the symptoms urgently. This will help to ensure that in the case of a positive test result, contacts of the person can self isolate promptly to prevent further spread of infection to the wider community.
