- **Flu Vaccinations:** following our participation in the Flu Vaccination Programme 2019/20 we are pleased that our overall uptake rate was 67% which was above the NHS target of 65%.
- Head Lice: we have had a lot of cases of head lice in school recently so thought we would just give you further
 information about how to prevent and treat it. Head lice are not a health hazard because they do not carry
 serious diseases but they are a persistent nuisance in schools. To control outbreaks it is important that you
 check your child's hair on a weekly basis and not just when you receive a text notifying you of cases in school. For
 more information on checking your child's hair and options available for treatment please follow the NHS link
 https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/head-lice-and-nits. If you find your child does have head lice, please inform the

school office and anyone who may have had head-to-head contact with your child. To help prevent the spread of head lice:

- o comb your child's hair regularly with a nit or bug-busting comb. You can buy these from you local pharmacist;
- o periodically inspect the hair of all the children in the family;
- o do not be embarrassed to tell the parents of any other children who may have had head-to-head contact with your child;
- o thank other parents if they let you know that their child has lice.
