#### 2. LET'S WORK TOGETHER

- **Keep in touch:** do keep in touch with the school about significant highs and lows that you and your family may be facing. We may be able to, help, point you in the direction of help or at least 'walk' with you in our thoughts and prayers. Email <a href="mailto:office@stnm.org.uk">office@stnm.org.uk</a>
- Change of circumstances: We appreciate that some families may have a significant change of circumstances owing to the lockdown. You will be entitled to free healthy school meals for your children, whatever year they are in, (saving you more than £350 a year) if you receive any of the following:
  - I. Income support or income-based Jobseekers Allowance or Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.
  - 2. The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit.
  - 3. Support from NASS National Asylum Support Service under Part 6 of Immigration & Asylum Act 1999.
  - 4. Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190 or less.)
  - 5. Universal Credit.

Did you know ... just registering your child for Free School Meals means that the school gets extra money (Pupil Premium)? For each child who is registered for free school meals, the school gets extra funding of £1320. Even if you don't want your child to have the school meals, as long as you qualify and are registered the school will still receive the extra funding, and will continue to do so even if your child is no longer eligible. This could be worth more than £9,000 to the school over a seven year period. If you would like to apply for pupil premium, please ask for an application form from the office or download it from the school website. If you have any questions, please be in touch.
