



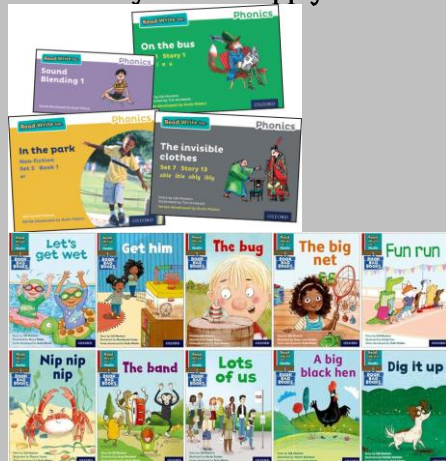

Reading

Your child should continue to read with you most nights of the week. It would be helpful if you could also ask a few questions about what they have read to encourage them to engage fully with the text. If they are fluent readers, they could read a section independently and then discuss with you what they have read. If your child is in a Read Write Inc group, they should be bringing home a phonics class paper RWI book, a RWI book bag book and a 'Reading for pleasure' book each. Please continue to fill in their reading diary and send your child into school with it every Monday to be checked! **Please ensure books come back to school as we have a very limited supply!**



Maths

It is so important for your child to keep learning/practising his or her times tables. Whether this is focussing on just the x2 or practising the x2, x5 and x10, daily practice of these really helps their progress. Sing them, chant them, work the answers out using physical resources... it all helps! Don't forget to look out for exciting online games and apps that support learning the times tables, e.g. Hit the Button. If your child is confident at answering 'random' x2, x5 and x10 questions, they can then learn the x3 and x4 and the corresponding division facts.

Telling the Time and Money

Please help your child to learn to tell the time in 5 minute intervals or at least to the quarter hour. Also whenever opportunities arise, please can children practice recognising coins and giving change.
