Child 2 AL: That's a small area but it is still home to over half the world's plants and animals.

Teacher EB: Well done children, who can tell me about the living conditions in the rainforest?

Child 3 SS: It's very very very warm in the rainforest.

Child 4 JBr: The best word to use is humid, not warm.

Child 5 PP: What does humid mean?

Child 9 MS: It means that it is warm and sticky and sweaty!

Child 6 EL: But the indigenous people who live in the rainforest are used to it just like we are used to living in Shoreham.

Teacher EB: Fantastic children! Right, home time.

All: good afternoon Mr Bridger. Good afternoon everybody

Children/teacher sit down. Mum, brother and 7&8 stand in middle of stage.

Dad walks in carrying briefcase.

Child 8 JM: Dad did you know that the rainforest stabilizes the world's climate?

Dad KM: That's interesting

Child 7 YR: Sam, did you know that the rainforest is a source for medicines and foods?

Brother TR: Really? I didn't know that? Pretty cool!

Mum RM: You are rainforest mad you are! You will be dreaming about rainforests!

Dad KM: Off to bed children, school in the morning!

Mum, Dad, Brother sit down. Child 7&8 curl up under blanket in middle of stage. Dreamy music which then switches to sounds of rainforest. Howler monkeys and toucans jump/flap onto stage.

Child 7&8 start to wake up.

- Howler monkey I HS: That sloth is really annoying me!
- Howler monkey 2 CA: He just lazes about in his tree all day
- Howler monkey 3 IR: We're trying to swing from branch to branch
- Howler monkey 4 OC: And he just lies right in our path, snoring snoring snoring!
- Toucan I MC: Have you tried howling at him?
- Toucan 2 ON: You are a howler monkey after all
- Toucan 3 JDW: We all know that your howl can be heard up to three miles away.

Anacondas slither on.

Howler monkey 5 HC: We've tried everything!

Howler monkeys trudge off

Anaconda | TJ: I don't know why they're whinging about a SSSsilly SSSsloth

Anaconda 2 JD: We have more important things to worry about

Anaconda 3 PG: Yeah, like our homesSSSS being cut down.

Toucan 4 JF: I know, we're really worried

Toucan 5 EJ: Jaguar Jane was saying that she heard the loggers talking about cutting our trees next!

Child 7 YR: What? Where are we?

Anaconda 4 ABI: You're in the AmazZZZZZon rainforesSSSSt.

Rainforest samba beat.

Tree frogs hop on.

Anaconda 5 AGS: It'sSSS in BrazZZZZil; it's the largesSSSt rainforesSSSt in the world!

Tree frog I CN: Although it is being chopped down at a scary rate!

Tree frog 2 JB: Will you help us?

Tree frog 3 WK: The loggers won't listen to us.

Tree frog 4 SP: Maybe you could persuade them to stop destroying our home?

Child 8 JM: We can try. But I don't really know what to say.

Tree frog 5 EH: Thank you!

Tree frogs and anacondas off. Rangers onto stage.

Ranger I LB: We can help tell you everything you need to know.

Ranger 2 WS: Every year an area of rainforest the size of Costa Rica is cut down and destroyed.

Ranger 3 JP: The plants and animals that used to live in these forests either die or must find a new forest to call their home.

Ranger 4 JBo: People are using the trees to make furniture, or clearing the land to make room to raise cattle.

Ranger 5 NM: Rainforests are disappearing very quickly.

Ranger 6 ABiz: The good news is that there are a lot of people who want to save rainforests.

Ranger 7 LL: The bad news is that saving rainforests is not going to be easy.

Ranger 8 SM: It will take people working together to make sure that rainforests and their wildlife survive.

Rangers sit down.

Trees stand up as they say their lines.

Tree I MH: T- To protect the rainforest we need to focus on "TREES":

Tree 2 ET: T- Teach others about how important the rainforest is.

Tree 3 PW: R- Replant trees to make up for the damage done.

Tree 4 FW: E- Encourage people to live in a way that doesn't hurt the environment.

Tree 5 MM: E- Establish parks to protect rainforests and wildlife.

Tree 6 BJ: S- Support companies that work in ways that do less damage to the environment.

Child 7 YR: We will try our best to spread the word!

Tree 7 JH: Shhhh! I can hear the loggers.

Deforestation dance/music

Child 7&8 jump out the way

Logger I EP: Another day's work finished. I am shattered!

Logger 2 KLS: Me too. But it's all worth it.

Logger 3 KD: *(rubs hands together)* Oh yes. We are going to get a lot of money for all of this wood.

Children 7 YR & 8 JM: Hey!!!

Logger 4 ST: Who are you?

Children 7 YR & 8 JM: We are here to stop you!

Logger 5 JL: We're so sorry you feel that way, but this is our job!

Logger 6 MG: Without this job, we have no money to feed our families

Logger 7 SJ: It is horrible for the animals though.

Logger 8 MA. Hey guys! We need to learn to be sustainable.

Logger 5 JL: You mean only cut down what we NEED?! That makes sense. (all nod vigorously)

Ranger I LB: Well that's a start. Kids, you look sleepy, why don't you take a nap and we can spread the word of sustainable development tomorrow?

Children go to sleep. They wake up back in bed at home.

Child 7 YR: *That* was a weird dream. But it's made me really want to do all that I can to help save the rainforest.

Advice I OE: There are several things you can do at home to help reduce your impact on the environment.

Advice 2 DB: Turn off lights when you don't need them. (Mr Mac turn the lights off) Advice 3 MD: Do not waste water and make sure you recycle. (wag finger)

ALL: Reduce, recycle, don't throw it away. Make something useful ev-ery day. HEY!

Child 8 JM: So who's with me? Shall we work together to save the rainforest?

ALL: YES!!!
