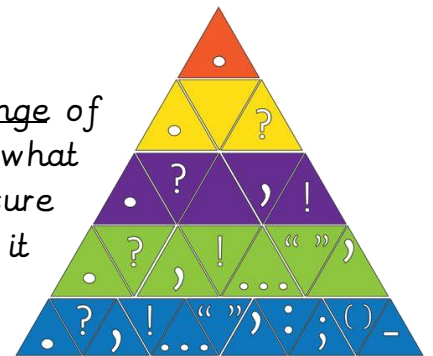
Editing session 1

- clear sentences that all make sense!

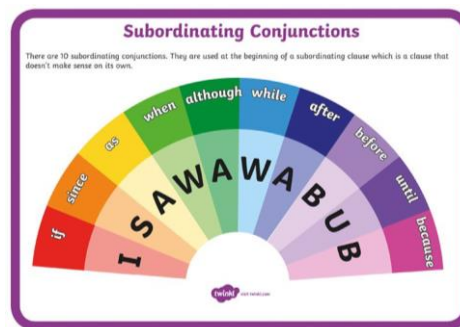
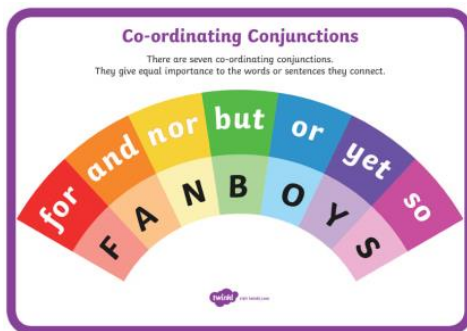
Editing session 2
