Top Tips for parents!

Years 3 and 4 are a time to become organised and be responsible for yourself and your learning.

For your child to become more independent, you can help in the following ways:

□ Ensure that ALL of their possessions are named including water bottles, PE kits, jumpers and coats. Encourage them to always put their belongings in the correct place and look for them independently before asking an adult to find something that has been misplaced.

□ Talk to your child about their learning each day and support them in completing any homework where necessary. It is always useful to know how much has been given on any task completed at home.

□ Assist with helping your child to become organised by reminding them of what is needed at school each day. Can they start to get everything ready themselves?

 $\hfill\square$ Listen to them read, every day if possible, and record this reading in their school Reading Log.

□ Practise spellings and times tables to encourage recall skills.
