Maths

It is so important for your child to keep learning/practising his or her times tables. Whether this is focussing on just the x2 or practising the x2, x5 and x10, daily practice of these really helps their progress. Sing them, chant them, work the answers out using concrete resources... it all helps! Don't forget to look out for exciting online games and apps that support learning the times tables, e.g. Hit the Button.

If your child is confident at answering 'random' x^2 , x^5 and x^{10} questions, they can then learn the x3 and x4 and the corresponding division facts.
